Returned in 1970 to again play Shires and work for promotion to Grade competition. Many others more involved than me.

Enjoyed great experiences and friendships, and some success. Enjoyed Intervarsity V Queensland, ACT, Western Australia, New England, Combined New Zealand Unis (1st encounter with John Rogers) that provided the chance to play against many interstate Sheffield Shield cricketers.

Played baseball (10 years) for UNSW when a winter sport.
